The general aim is to develop emotional skills and interpersonal relationships in teenagers at risk of social exclusion and, as a consequence, achieve their full inclusion in society, together with the horizontal priority 'Inclusion and diversity in all areas of education, training, youth and sport'.

















Target groups

Secondary school teachers who work in direct contact with young people at risk of exclusion.

Teenagers aged 12 to 17 at risk of exclusion, as it is an ideal scenario for deconstructing the stereotypes that generate discrimination.
